## **Rutgers Turfgrass Research Golf Classic**

Rutgers University, the Center for Turfgrass Science, and the New Jersey Turfgrass Foundation are proud to host the 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Rutgers Turfgrass Research Golf Classic on **Monday, May 7, 2018,** at Fiddler's Elbow Country Club, Bedminster, New Jersey.

This event has raised more than \$1,700,000 over the past twenty-two years! These funds have been used to support practical, problem-solving research, student scholarships, and new facilities for the Rutgers Turfgrass Program. Recent examples of practical Rutgers Turf Research that have been supported by funds from the Golf Classic include:

- [ Golf Course Superintendents now have available to them valuable information on how to best manage Agrostis and Poa annua putting greens with a history of anthracnose, dollar spot, and summer turf decline.
- I Rutgers world-renowned turfgrass breeders release dozens of new cultivars each year with improved insect, disease and stress tolerance.
- I Rutgers scientists have conducted pioneering research related to turfgrass stress physiology and the mechanisms of heat and drought tolerance in cool-season grasses.
- I Rutgers research on sand topdressing, fertilization, mowing, rolling and growth regulators on Agrostis and Poa annua greens has provided superintendents with important decision making information.
- Tor. Matt Elmore, Extension Specialist in Turfgrass Weed Science, was hired with support of the New Jersey Turfgrass Foundation.
- T For sports turf use, Rutgers researchers continue to evaluate Kentucky bluegrasses, perennial ryegrasses, and tall fescues for wear and traffic stress tolerance.
