FUNDING TURF ADVANCEMENTS #7: **New Drainage Swale at Rutgers Hort. Farm II**

It is lovely when April showers bring May flowers, but this year's September rain caused a problematic overflow of water on the Rutgers Horticulture Farm II test plots. During a heavy storm this past autumn, the rainwater rose too high and started running onto some of the newly seeded turfgrass research plots. The implications of flooding go without saying.

Thanks to funding from the NJTA, the team at Rutgers Center for Turfgrass Science hired Advanced Athletic Services of [The Viersma Companies](#) to reconstruct an existing drainage swale.



“The existing swale was not large enough to effectively move the water around the test plots as intended,” said Howard Viersma, who led the construction project.

Using an excavator to dig, a tractor with a dump wagon to move the soil, and a track skid steer for the grading, Howard and his team spent three days excavating a deeper and more consistent drainage swale to handle a larger volume of water.

“One consideration was maintenance,” said Howard. “We wanted to create a swale deep enough to solve the

problem at hand, but not too steep that it can't be maintained by standard mowing equipment.”

After careful deliberation, they created a 400-foot long swale with a third of one percent slope. The steeper side slopes of the swale made it challenging to sod with big rolls, but the new drainage swale is now complete and Rutgers' newly seeded turfgrass test plots are out of flooding harm's way.

“This was a game saver!” said Rutgers' Extension Specialist Dr. James Murphy. “The swale reconstruction saved the 2018 NTEP tall fescue, which would have been washed out several times by rain storms this fall.”
