<p>‡ Rutgers world-renowned turfgrass breeders release dozens of new cultivars each year with improved insect, disease and stress tolerance.</p>	<p>‡ Rutgers scientists have developed important information on insecticide resistance in annual bluegrass weevil and how to avoid and manage resistance.</p>
<p>‡ Rutgers scientists have conducted pioneering research related to turfgrass stress physiology and the mechanisms of heat and drought tolerance in cool-season grasses.</p>	<p>‡ For sports turf use, Rutgers researchers continue to evaluate Kentucky bluegrasses, perennial ryegrasses, and tall fescues for wear and traffic stress tolerance.</p>
